There is also no doubt that for many Americans the war on Iraq was a day of apocalyptic judgment. The solution, the evidently fearless minister decided – harking back to an answer Egyptian bureaucrats have seized upon since long before Islam – is to centralize it. The usual apocalyptic suspects are therefore not only ghosts and other super-human aliens, but suspicious strangers of all kinds who have become domesticated.

There are no discussion topics on this book. The radicalism of the current regime is thus based on the apocalyptic and moral enthusiasms of the Christian right, although in its policy formulations it is the secularized religion of democracy that is being used to provide ideological cover for expansionism and intervention. That context is a vision of endtimes in which old grievances are given bloody satisfaction, and the righteous will be comforted by the sight of the suffering of the wicked. Unfortunately, since September 11, apocalyptic visions of the coming battle with the forces of evil have gained political currency and have legitimated the pre-emptive use of nuclear arms.

For the remainder, the end is quite simply torment followed by extinction. In this issue of apocalyptic is dealt with in an immediately apparent way that links contemporary, biblical and other historical periods together in a way that displays the naturalness of apocalyptic within the human condition.
